RE or EE ?

The cleanest Energy is the energy which is not used!

Accordingly:

The solution of energy problems is a more efficient use of energy, supported by RE in case new generation capacities are necessary.

As long as end energy is wasted on the consumption side (in MENA: tremendously) neither conventional nor RE will not be able to meet the demand.

Change of the approach also in MENA!

- ***NEEAPs (Nat.EE Actions Plans): LEB, JOR, PAL (others: EGY, TUN, SUD,.....)***
- ***PAL: Awarded by LAS for its best practice in the region of implementing the NEEAP***
- ***Continuous Improvement of the Procedures: Developing a Methodology for Monitoring the Progress of NEEAPs (with LAS)***

Change of the approach also in MENA! Cont.

- *EE Building Code Road Maps – MENA; JOR, MOR, TUN*
- *Training Courses on EE: EE Lighting, EE Auditing, ESCos*
- *ESCo Development: Road Maps for MENA region,*

Change of the approach also in MENA! Cont.

Concerted activities of the League of Arab States to implement EE policy in it's member countries supported by regional organizations and projects (e.g. ESCWA, RCREEE, MED-ENEC)

- *Regular regional and national training WS – e.g. on ESCo (national: e.g. ALG, EGY; regional: Granada)*
- *On NEEAPs; a common template; Monitoring methodology*
- *EE Building Code Development*
