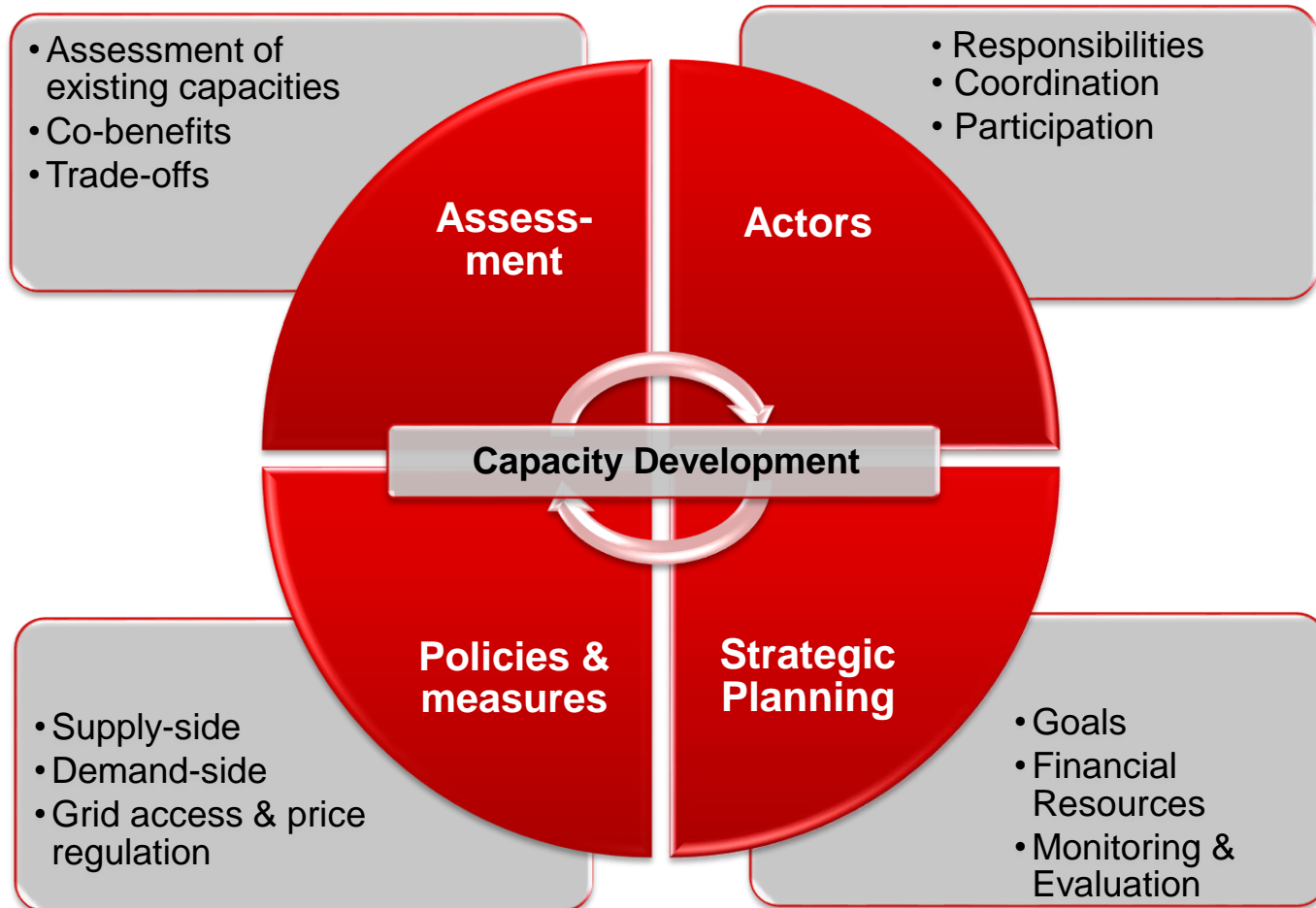

Issue: Monitoring & evaluation

- M&E should be an on-going learning process, based on indicators and benchmarks, on regular progress reporting and impact evaluation
- Monitoring and evaluation is important to:
 - measure progress
 - learn from identified shortcomings and adjust policies
 - respond to changing environment
 - To create or renew momentum
- Aspects of designing monitoring & evaluation processes:
 - What should be evaluated by whom?
 - What data and methodologies are used in the process?
 - How to monitor non-energy effects of energy policy strategies?



Good practice options on monitoring & evaluation

- What should be evaluated by whom?
 - India: Inter-Ministerial Council on Climate Change reviews National Solar Mission (NSM) with participation from non-governmental stakeholders + Worlds bank reviews every 3-year
 - Mexico's advisory council on RE reviews RE policy (includes gov. ministries, agencies and civil society representatives)
 - China's mid-term review of the Five-Year Plan involving internal and external reviews and different stakeholders
- Monitoring of non-energy effects:
 - South Africa: M&E of SA local content shares; evaluation against local content roadmap
