


# Pindulani ndi CHITETEZO MBAULA mu mchaka cha 2008

portable convenient

Ndimantha kuphikila nyengo yosefukira madzi  
I like the stove because I can carry it to a convenient place. Flooding no longer disturbs me, I move the stove to a dry place to cook. (Naanje)



Ndimbaula ya chitetezo ndi kugwiritsa ntchito nkhusi zochepta kwambiri, moti pa mulungu umodzi wokha ndabweza ndalama zomwe ndinagulira mbaula.  
(Salayekha Mphepo, Njedza township, Mulanje)  
Since I cook on Chitetezo Mbaula I use far less money for firewood.  
By saving 30 MK per day, the stove has paid off within one week.

Chitetezo Mbaula protects my house: my roof will not catch fire in the windy season because the flames are contained in the stove (Rumphi)
