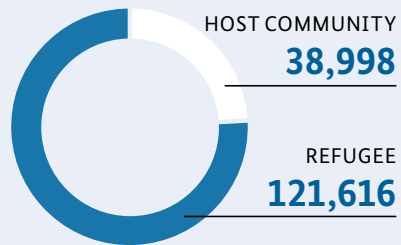


# Impact: Energy Solutions for Displacement Settings

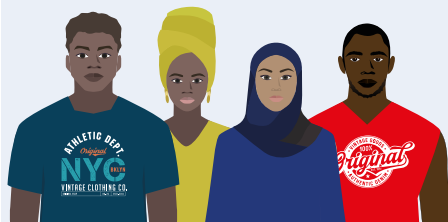

## Project Data July 2022

The Energy Solutions for Displacement Settings (SUN-ESDS) is a component of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) commissioned Global SUN Programme with UNHCR. GIZ implements the project and works closely with the UNHCR and local partners to provide energy solutions that cater to the needs of both refugee and host communities in project countries – **Ethiopia, Kenya and Uganda**. The project works through three intervention areas – Improving the policy framework; Greening the UNHCR infrastructure; and Increasing market-based energy access. The current implementation timeline is between 2018–2022.
