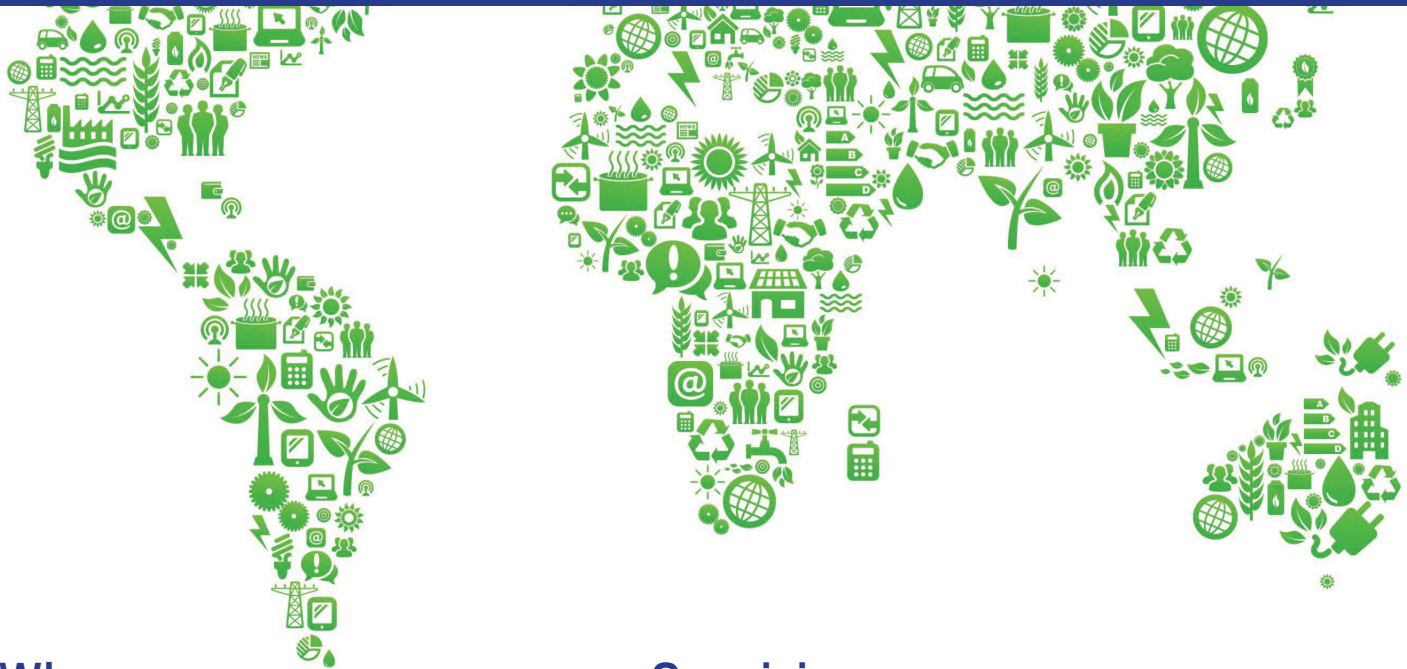


About energypedia

Since then, www.energypedia.info grew into the one-stop information point with over one million page views per year.
