- Currently 11 small scale/ micro scale projects Listed on the Registry
- Countries include Kenya, Uganda, Ethiopia and Ghana
- Initial projects based in Kenya
- 2 small scale projects registered
- Another 2 in the final stages of registration

## **CDM Projects**



- POA in Kenya going through validation
- Other POA's in development in East and West Africa and Asia

## The Stove Technology



- Currently wood only stove
- Centrally manufactured in country from locally sourced materials
- Stove quality and efficiency maintained by internal QC points in the factory and at point of assembly
- Distributed and assembled by the local community
- Continuous development

- Our processes are in line with current GS and CDM methodology
- Sampling and analysis carried out by independent 3<sup>rd</sup> Parties
- Data gathered by trained community based NGO staff overseen by co2balance staff in country

#### **Stove Dissemination**




- Currently supply stoves for free

- Uploaded on to electronic database

- Used to increase the awareness of deforestation through education

- Education programme to ensure stove use
